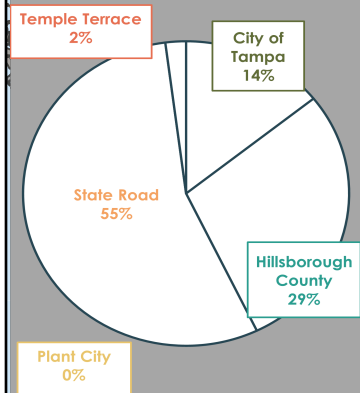

Fatal Crashes by Month

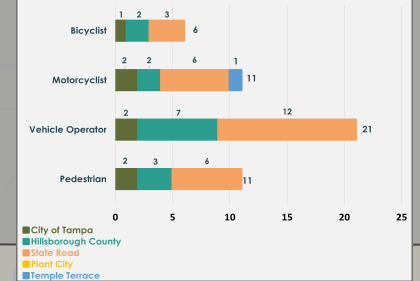
