### **SS4A Grant Background**

USDOT Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Grant Program

- Established in the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law
- \$5 billion over 5 years for safety projects
- Hillsborough County awards
  - \$19.7M Implementation Grant in FY22
  - \$9.9M Demonstration Grant in FY23





#### **SS4A Demonstration Grant Components**

- Supplemental planning activities
  - Safety Action Plan updates and development
  - Data collection to measure success and/or impact
  - Stakeholder engagement and collaboration
- Demonstration activities
  - Feasibility and engineering studies
  - Installation of temporary materials
  - Behavioral or operational activity pilot programs
  - New technology pilot programs









#### Hillsborough County Facts

#### Why Hillsborough County?

- Students walking within 2-mile school radius
- 6% of County population is transit dependent and relies on public transportation
- Pedestrian fatality rate is 3x higher than the national average for comparably sized counties
- Bicyclist-involved crashes make up almost 10% percent of all crashes
- Crashes at unsignalized intersections make up 25% of all crashes but experience over 50% of the fatal and lifealtering injury crashes
- Large underserved population (40% of residents)







### Hillsborough County Grant Facts

- Projects address vulnerable roadway users
- Projects are on or access the High Injury Network
- 83% of project investments are in underserved communities
- Projects identified in 6 County Safety Programs through data-driven analysis and high-risk locations






### **County Demonstration Project**

- High visibility pavement markings






#### **Grant Timeline**
