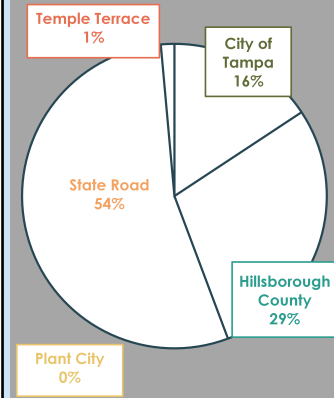

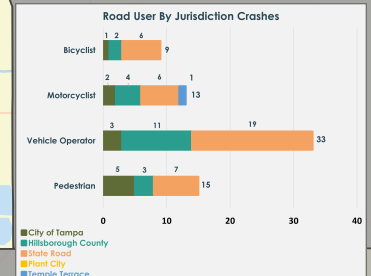


### Fatal Crashes by Month
