# THANKSGIVING SAFETY TIPS FOR DRIVERS

**Never drive impaired.** Plan ahead with a designated driver or rideshare.

**Report dangerous drivers.** Call \*FHP (\*347) or 911 if you see impaired or aggressive driving.

**Buckle up.** Make sure everyone is properly restrained, including kids in car seats.

**Follow the speed limit.** Be courteous to other drivers.

**Stay focused.** Keep your hands on the wheel, eyes on the road, and mind on driving.

**Rest before driving.** Drowsy driving is just as risky as impaired driving.

**Move over. It's the law.** Move over a lane when you approach a stopped vehicle on the side of the road. Learn more at [FLHSMV.gov/MoveOver](https://www.flhsmv.gov/MoveOver).

**Check your vehicle.** Before a trip, inspect fluids, tires (including the spare), and overall maintenance.
