



THANKSGIVING SAFETY TIPS FOR DRIVERS

Never drive impaired. Plan ahead with a designated driver or rideshare.

Report dangerous drivers. Call *FHP (*347) or 911 if you see impaired or aggressive driving.

Buckle up. Make sure everyone is properly restrained, including kids in car seats.

Follow the speed limit. Be courteous to other drivers.

Stay focused. Keep your hands on the wheel, eyes on the road, and mind on driving.

Rest before driving. Drowsy driving is just as risky as impaired driving.

Move over. It's the law. Move over a lane when you approach a stopped vehicle on the side of the road. Learn more at FLHSMV.gov/MoveOver.

Check your vehicle. Before a trip, inspect fluids, tires (including the spare), and overall maintenance.
