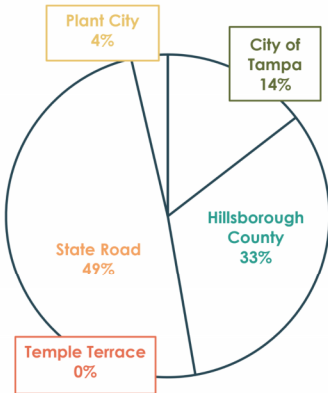

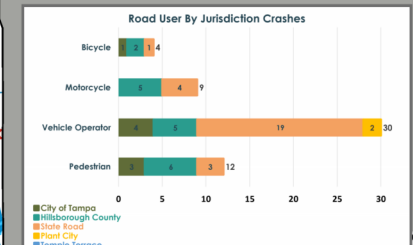
Fatal Crashes by Month

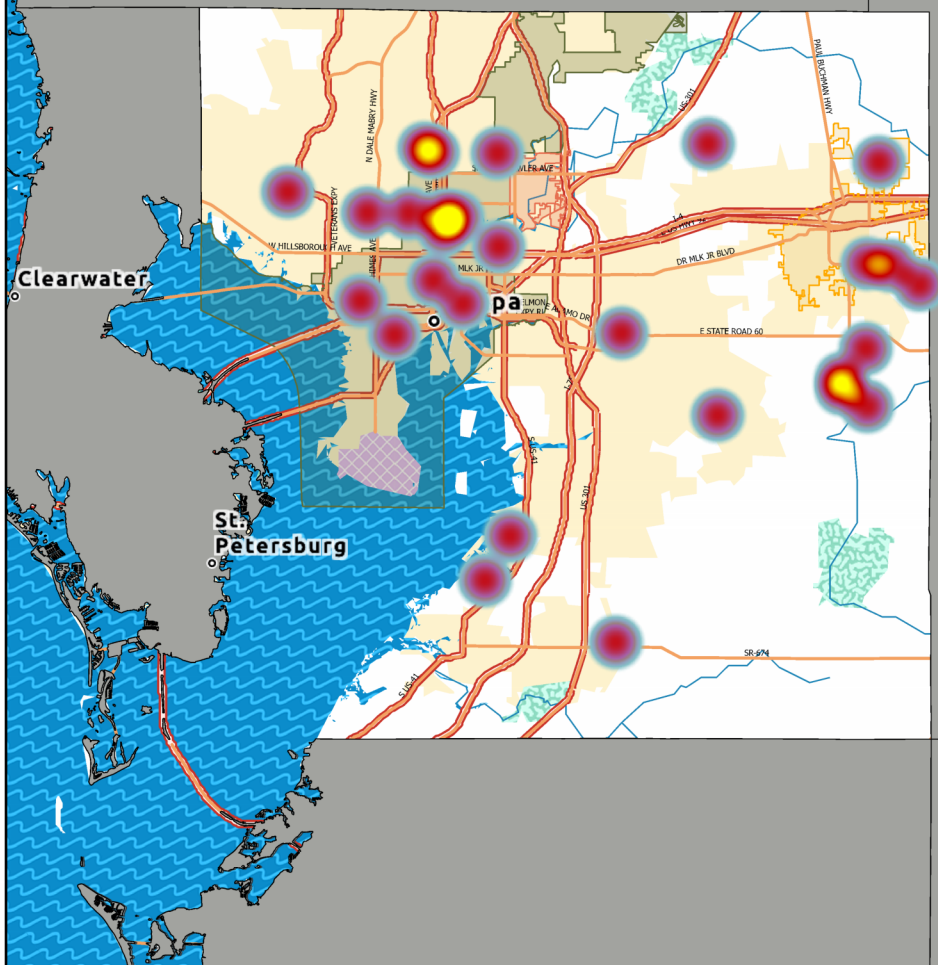

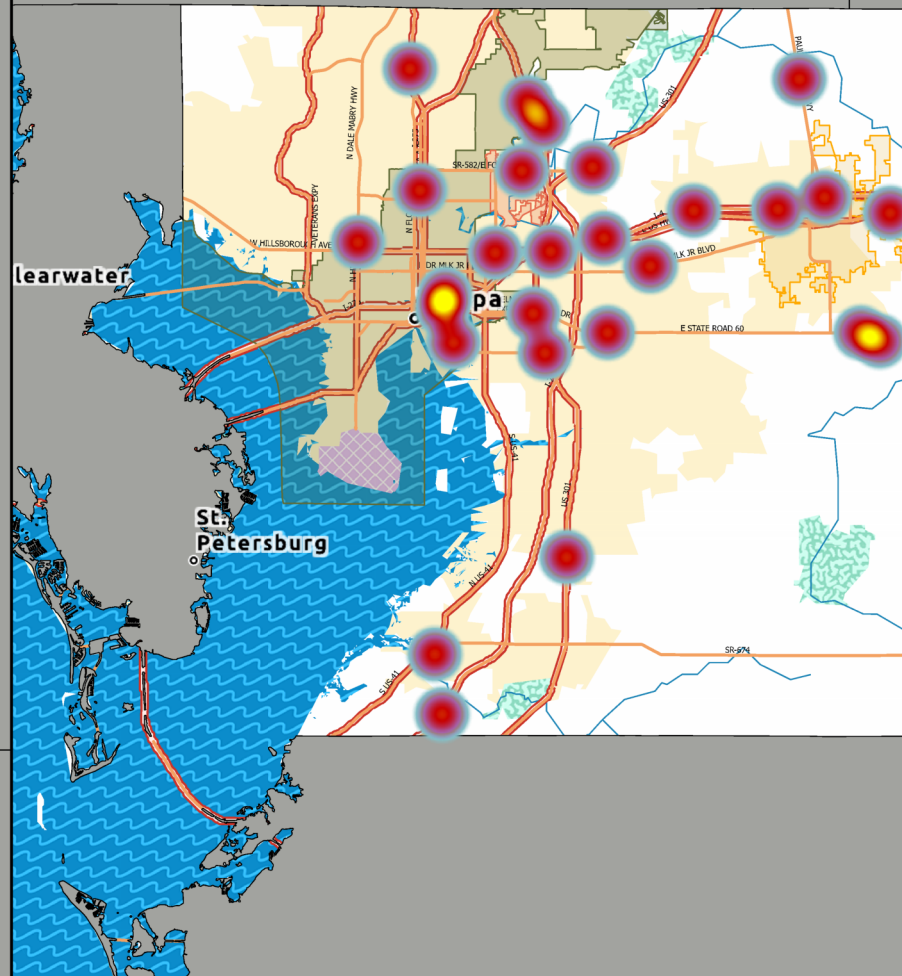
